# Career Academies

# NCAA

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- Division I and Division II college athletics require NCAA eligibility
- In order to be eligible for DI or DII competition, you must meet certain academic requirements in high school

# Course Selection

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## CORE CLASSES

Typically require a teacher recommendation:

- English
- Math
- Science
- Social Studies

*\* Some core subjects also offer elective options, which may not need a teacher recommendation*

## ELECTIVE CLASSES

YOU choose these classes:

- Consider the graduation requirements
- What are your career goals?
- What are your passions/interests?
- What do your dream colleges want to see on your transcript?
- What skills do you need for employment?

# Physical Education

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- Adapted Physical Education → *requires teacher recommendation*
- General PE
- Intramural Sports
- Lifeguarding Certification → *Students must turn 15 yrs old by May 1<sup>st</sup> of year taking the class*
- Lifetime Activities
- Net/Wall Games
- PE Mixed 9-12 → *for MUSIC ENSEMBLE students ONLY...scheduled opposite rehearsal days*
- Performance Strength Training (Sm1 or Sm2) → *MUST be on a CCHS athletic team*
- Physical Education / Driver's Education
- Sports Officiating
- Strength Training → *for any student NOT on a CCHS athletic team*
- Unified PE → *requires teacher and/or counselor approval*

# Course Descriptions

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- **READ THEM!** It is important to know what you are selecting → it is not always possible to change classes once the school year begins
- Pay close attention to the following:
  - **Grade level** → Are you in the correct grade level to take the course?
  - **Credit amount** → Is the class a full or half credit? Will it work in your schedule?
  - **Prerequisites** → Have you taken the appropriate introductory level courses to prepare you for more advanced options? Did you earn high enough grades in those introductory courses?

# Course Change Requests

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Life is full of challenges. School is no different. When considering a course change, Cedar Crest High School has a process that students should follow to assist them with persevering and building necessary skills to succeed in life.

This process is outlined on page 9 of the Educational Planning Guide.

Once the master schedule is created, course changes are not always possible → classes might be full, classes may not fit in your schedule, and/or requests for changes may not be approved.

# Course Registration Assistance

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- **Lunch Chats:** February 3-7 during ALL lunch periods → Best for quick questions
- **Email School Counselor:** Responses may be a little slower during this time
- **One-on-One School Counselor Appointments**
  - Best for longer, more in-depth questions
  - Appointments cannot be scheduled through email → Please stop by the Counseling Office to make appointments with your counselor
- **Evening Hours:** February 5 and 6, 2025 from 2:30pm-6pm
  - Appointments are not required but highly recommended
- **Course Registration Planner:**
  - Assists students with mapping out courses and ensuring all graduation requirements are met → see supplementary handout

# Filling out the Form

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1. Put your FULL, legal name at the top of the paper (first AND last name please!)
2. Write your cell phone number, if you have one
3. Circle the name of your school counselor
4. Write your CURRENT career goal where indicated
5. Circle the corresponding Career Academy where indicated
6. **Look at Skyward** → make sure the core classes you discussed with your recommending teachers are correct and write them on your registration form
  - Ask for assistance if you aren't sure what to do!!!

8. **Select a minimum of THREE alternate courses** → be sure to include some ½ credit options in case they are needed
9. Indicate your lunch preference where applicable
10. Ensure all credits add up correctly
  - Seniors must register for a minimum of 6.0 credits (unless your counselor tells you otherwise)
  - Underclassmen must register for a minimum of 7.0 credits
