## **Cedar Crest High School Graduation Requirements**

## All of the following requirements must be met to earn a Cedar Crest High School diploma:

- 1. Follow a career academy
- 2. Complete a four-year program
- 3. Accumulate a minimum of 24.0 credits
- **4. In Grade 12:** Register for a minimum of 6.0 credits More than 6.0 credits may be needed for some students to meet all graduation requirements

In grades 9-11: Register for a minimum of 7.0 credits per year

## 5. Successfully complete the following courses:

- 4 credits in **English** (core)
- 3 credits in Mathematics → some colleges/universities and/or majors may require 4 credits of math on the transcript
- 3 credits in **Social Studies** → all students must pass 1 credit of American Cultures, 1 credit of World Cultures, and at least 0.5 credit of U.S. Government
- 3 credits in **Science** to include 1 credit of Biology → some colleges/universities and/or majors may require 4 credits of science on the transcript
- 1.5 credits in Physical Education
- 0.5 credit in Health
- 0.5 credit in Fine Art or Music
- 0.5 credit in Career Development → Options include:
  - o Business and Career Development
  - DIY Home Improvement
  - o Introduction to Technology and Problem-Solving
  - Computer Science Foundations 1
  - Any Family and Consumer Science Course
- 0.5 credit in **Financial Literacy** (Saving, Investing, and Financial Decisions)
- 6. Successfully complete the **Smart Futures** course during grades 9-12 as well as the Exit Interview during senior year
- 7. Meet the statewide **Keystone Exam** graduation requirement as outlined in Senate Bill 1095 that expands options for students to demonstrate postsecondary readiness using four additional pathways that more fully illustrate college, career, and community readiness
- \* While **foreign language** is not a graduation requirement for Cedar Crest High School, most colleges and universities require successful completion of at least 2.0 credits of the same foreign language. Some colleges/universities may require more than 2.0 credits.
