



### **SCHOLARSHIP TRUST APPLICATION GUIDELINES**

- Seniors who wish to be considered for a Cedar Crest Music Aides Scholarship must complete an application and return it to their music director or to the Music Aides mailbox in the high school office by **3:00pm on Friday, March 31, 2023**.
- Students must be furthering a music career in the fields of Music Education, Music Performance, Music Business, Music Therapy, Music Recording Technology, or other like majors, at an accredited college, school of music or school of performing arts in order to qualify for the highest given amounts. Students who elect to minor in music, OR who do not major/minor in music, BUT plan to participate in collegiate music ensembles will be considered for other scholarship amounts.
- Recipient(s) of the scholarship(s) will be chosen by the Cedar Crest Music Aides Scholarship Trust Board of Governors after review of all complete applications. Cedar Crest Music Aides reserves the right to suspend the award if no suitable candidates are found.
- Applications are available in the High School Guidance Office or from any of the high school music directors.
- Recipient(s) will be notified in May of the Board's decision. The decision of the Board is final.
- The application form must be filled out and returned along with the following:
  - On a separate sheet of paper, using NO LESS than 300 words, explain the program of study you plan to pursue, your educational aims, career objectives, and ambitions you hope to realize.
  - A personal resume including accomplishments both musically and academically. Items should be listed in chronological order and be presented in a professional format.
  - Official copy of your HS transcript (sent directly to the CCMA Mailbox in the HS Office).
  - Letters of Recommendation – minimum of two (2). CCHS music teachers are NOT eligible to write letters. Please consider other CLSD music staff, CCHS teachers, and/or private teachers.
  - Performance Component (for those who plan to major in music ONLY) – submit a performance video on your major instrument to the Board (application review panel). Repertoire selected should be no longer than five (5) minutes in length, but should demonstrate your highest level of musical skill and ability. Must be appropriate high school literature or higher.
