Michael H. Wise, II was 32 years old when he was killed in the line of duty in June 2004 while serving as a Reading City Police Officer. As a way to celebrate his life and do good deeds in his name, Mike's friends, family, and co-workers created the Michael H. Wise, II Memorial Foundation, Inc. (Foundation).

Mike was a 1990 graduate Cedar Crest High School, a 1993 graduate of the Center for Emergency Medicine in Pittsburgh, PA and a 2002 graduate of the Reading Police Academy. He served the public first, as an EMT/Paramedic, and then, as a Police Officer.

Throughout the year, the Foundation raises money through several fundraisers. Every year, the Foundation hosts a motorcycle ride, a golf outing, and a 5K/Kids Fun Run. All proceeds from these events are used to fund scholarships for children of police officers and firefighters as well as local students looking to pursue careers in public service, specifically law enforcement or emergency medical services. The Wise Family receives no compensation from any events held by the Foundation.

The Foundation also identifies worthwhile charitable causes on an individual case basis. It saw a need for local K-9 officers who needed K-9 first aid kits and responded by donating them to several local agencies. Money was also donated to help local police departments fund the purchase of dogs for K-9 units. Emergency ID cards were donated and issued to Lebanon City Firefighters in the event that family members need to be contacted immediately. Several schools in Lebanon and Berks Counties needed to be equipped with defibrillators (AEDs) and again, the Foundation responded by purchasing and donating units to schools. **Two AEDs donated by the Foundation have already been credited with saving lives.**

The Michael H. Wise, II Memorial Foundation, Inc. is honored to assist the next generation of emergency services heroes in achieving their goals in education and takes great pride in being able to help the community in Mike's name.
